When asked what her favorite parts of the trips were, Julie replied, "It is hard to pick one place over the other, since they are so different, so I would say the friendships that you make on the journey with the other members. We have so much fun on these trips, especially on the glacier trip. If you are thinking of going, and you don't have anyone to go with, give it a shot.
